The petitioner has filed this petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus to direct the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioner for granting the SHO/ Inspector/ Local Rank in view of letter/ Circular dated 23.01.2020 (Annexure P-1) issued by respondent No.2 as the same benefits have been granted by this court to the similarly situated persons vide order dated 08.09.2020 passed in CWP-13784-2020 and order dated 21.09.2020 passed in CWP-14875-2020, along with certain other prayers.

At the outset, the counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage the petitioner would be satisfied if respondents are directed to

decide the representation dated 29.09.2021 (Annexure P-3) served by the petitioner, within some time bound frame.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Ayush Sarna, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State and submits that the State is not averse to expeditious disposal of grievance of the petitioner.

In view of the above, respondents are directed to take a conscious decision in the representation dated 29.09.2021 (Annexure P-3), within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

The petition stands disposed of with above said direction.
