The matter has been taken up through Video conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioner has come up in this civil writ petition under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *certiorari* quashing the impugned order dated 11.09.2020 (Annexure P-4) and writ of *mandamus* directing the official respondents to release the service benefits including family pension, national pension scheme funds, group insurance scheme funds, ex-gratia, death-cum-retiral gratuity and leave encashment alongwith interest @ 18% per annum for which, representation dated 18.08.2020 (Annexure P-3) has also been submitted before the respondent-authorities.

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, the directions are issued to the respondent-authorities to duly consider the representation dated 18.08.2020 (Annexure P-3) of the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of passing of this order.

If the petitioner is held entitled for so claimed relief and there is no impediment for granting the same, the relief be released to her without any delay as per law.
