This matter is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of the pandemic, COVID-19.

Petitioner, who is a retired Head Teacher seeks certain benefits of pay scale in view of order dated 15.04.2009 passed in CWP No. 3931 of 1992, Annexure P-4.

It is submitted that similarly situated persons have already been afforded the benefits in question, though arrears have been restricted for the period of 38 months prior to filing of their writ petition/s.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State submits that representation/ legal notice dated 14.07.2020, Annexure P-6, submitted by the petitioner is under active consideration and is likely to be decided soon.

At this state, learned counsel for the petitioners restricts his prayer for a direction to the competent authority to decide her legal notice dated 14.07.2020, Annexure P-6, in a time bound manner.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case and the limited prayer addressed, but without expressing any opinion on the merits

of the case, this writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority, to decide legal notice dated 14.07.2020, Annexure P-6 submitted by the petitioner, by passing a speaking order, within four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case, the petitioner is found entitled to any benefit, same be released to her within two weeks thereafter.
