This is the second petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR no.0013 dated 07.02.2019 registered under Section 302 IPC at Police Station Manimajra, Chandigarh.

Learned APP for the U.T. Chandigarh has pointed out that in the present case, Krishan Pal, Mohinder Parshad, Rajkania and Anuj Kumar are the material witnesses and none of them have been examined as yet.

In view of the said fact, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks the withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to file a fresh one after the said material witnesses have been examined.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.

Since the petitioner has been in custody since 04.03.2019, thus

the U.T.-respondent is directed to examine the said four witnesses as expeditiously as possible. The trial Court is also requested to examine said witnesses as expeditiously as possible.

Since the main case has been decided, pending applications also stand disposed of in view of the above order.
