This petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order dated nil received on 23.10.2020 (Annexure P-3), issued by respondent No.3, whereby the petitioner was directed to vacate his government quarter No. 4 (H) Type, which is against the order dated 21.1.2013 (Annexure P-5), passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court; and the order dated 1.4.2014 (Annexure P-6), passed by this Court, whereby the petitioner was ordered for adjustment in view of the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court and which is also against his own policy decision dated 11.4.2012 (Annexure P-1), passed by respondent No.2. Further prayer of the petitioner is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent No.3 not to eject the petitioner from his above mentioned accommodation during the pendency of the present writ petition.

The counsel for the respondents has submitted that the petitioner

has been permitted to continue occupying the aforesaid Government Quarter No.4 (H) Type. Hence, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

The counsel for the petitioner has not disputed the above said fact.

In view of the above, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

Disposed of as infructuous.
