MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU, J.

Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned orders dated 14.08.2020 (P-9 & P-10, respectively), vide which, petitioners have been transferred from Hisar District to Fatehabad District in contravention of the policy/guidelines.

After arguing for some time, learned Counsel for the petitioners does not press the present petition with liberty to direct the competent authority to consider and decide the representations dated 11.08.2020 (P-7 & P-8) in accordance with law expeditiously.

Prayer seems to be justified.

Learned State Counsel has raised no objection in case the innocuous prayer of the petitioners is accepted.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to the competent authority to consider and decide the representations dated 11.08.2020 (P-7 & P-8) expeditiously in accordance with law preferably within two weeks from today if there is no legal impediment.

It is clarified that in case the desired representation is not decided within the stipulated time, the same shall be considered as disobedience of the order of this Court.

Since main writ petition stands disposed off, therefore, the pending applications, if any, shall also dispose off.
