Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that due to the outbreak of pandemic of Covid-19, the petitioner was granted the benefit of parole upto 16.08.2021. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that during the period the petitioner was on parole, he was diagnosed with certain ailments, for which he needed urgent medical treatment and therefore, the petitioner submitted a representation dated 18.08.2021 (Annexure P/5) to respondent No.4 for the extension of the parole, which is still pending consideration with respondent No.4 and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.4 to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Ramdeep Partap Singh, DAG, Punjab, who is present in the

Court, accept notice on behalf of respondent-State and raises no objection in

deciding representation dated 18.08.2021 (Annexure P/5) submitted by the petitioner to respondent No.4 in a time bound manner by passing appropriate speaking order.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in the representation dated 18.08.2021 (Annexure P/5), respondent No.4 is directed to decide said representation dated 18.08.2021 (Annexure P/5) submitted by the petitioner by passing a speaking order within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
