This is a petition filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure by the petitioner, seeking regular bail in case FIR No.645 dated 10.08.2018, under Sections 417, 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B and 201 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Sonipat City, District Sonipat.

2. The petitioner has remained in detention for more than three months, since 27.09.2020. After completion of investigation, challan against him has already been submitted.
