Prayer in the petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.96 dated 03.09.2021 under Section 406 and 498-A of the IPC, registered at Police Station Women, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that on account of a matrimonial dispute between the parties, the FIR in question came to be registered. He further submits that the parties have amicably settled their dispute before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court.

Report has been received from the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court wherein the matter has indeed been settled between the parties.

Learned counsel for the complainant does not dispute the submissions made by the counsel opposite qua the parties having indeed arrived at an amicable settlement.

Learned State counsel submits that in compliance of order dated 08.11.2021, the petitioner has already joined the investigation, cooperated with the investigating agency and he is not required for further investigation.

In view of above, order dated 08.11.2021 granting interim bail to petitioner, is made absolute. Petitioner shall abide by the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. in letter and spirit.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
