Case taken up through video conferencing.

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.94 dated 09.04.2021, under Sections 323, 324, 34, 427, 452, 506 IPC (Section 307 added later on), registered at Police Station Dujana, District Jhajjar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been attributed a knife blow on the hand of the complainant. He further contends that the complainant has fully recovered from the injuries. The petitioner is in custody for about 5 months since his arrest on 24.06.2021. He also contends that co-accused Ajit Godara has been granted regular bail by this court in CRM-M-31312-2021 on 06.08.2021.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Gautam, contends that challan has been filed but no prosecution witness has been examined.

Heard.

In view of the above, especially when the petitioner is in custody for over 5 months, the COVID-19 pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is

likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.

Criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
