Case taken up through video conferencing.

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.230 dated 26.12.2020 under Sections 148, 149, 323, 307, 506 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Bicchor, District Nuh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the son of the petitioner, namely, Arshad was consuming alcohol outside the house of the complainant which led to an altercation between the parties. The petitioner is alleged to have fired a shot which hit the ankle of the injured. The injured has fully recovered from the injury. Co-accused Arshad, who is the son of the petitioner, has expired on 06.09.2021. She further contends that the petitioner is over 52 years of age and is in custody for over 9 ½ months since his arrest on 26.12.2020. The petitioner is not involved in any other case. She also contends that the matter has been compromised and has sent a copy of the compromise deed dated 09.09.2021, which is taken on record.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Parkash Chand, states that although challan has been filed but charges are yet to be framed.

Heard.

In view of the above especially when the petitioner is in custody for over 9 ½ months, he is not involved in any other case, the injured has fully recovered from the injury, the matter has been compromised, the Covid-19 pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
