ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

On 12.11.2020, a Coordinate Bench of this Court had passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in the present case the petitioner was not named in the FIR. It was only on the basis of the disclosure statement of the co-accused that he was nominated. He has further submitted that the petitioner has a certificate of approval vide Annexure P-2 and is qualified to acquire mining lease of minor minerals in the State of Punjab. He has further submitted that earlier also he moved a petition before the learned Additional Sessions Judge and sought anticipatory bail but it was dismissed on the ground that at that point of time he was not nominated as an accused, thereafter, he was falsely implicated in the present case.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Monika Jalota, DAG,

Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State and states that she does not have complete instructions in this regard and will seek instructions.

Adjourned to 18.11.2020.

Till next date only, in the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds/surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rajwinder Singh, states that although the petitioner has joined investigation but recovery is yet to be effected.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 12.11.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
