The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.189 dated 21.09.2017, under Sections 307, 452, 34, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Rama Mandi, District Jalandhar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is alleged that the petitioner had given a knife blow on the neck of the daughter of the complainant. The injured has fully recovered from the injury. He also contends that the petitioner is 45 year old lady and she is in custody for over two years and three months. The petitioner does not have any criminal antecedents.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Balwinder Kumar, states that the petitioner is the mother-in-law of the daughter of the complainant and had caused serious injury to her. He also contends that 12 out of 20 prosecution witnesses have been examined.

Heard.

In view of the above especially when the petitioner is a lady, she is in custody for over two years and three months, the Covid-19 pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on her furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
