The reply filed by the SSP, Tarn Taran, dated 27.10.2021, is ordered to be taken on record.

It has been stated by the SSP that pursuant to the order dated October 06, 2021, petitioner no.1 (Anju Verma) has joined investigation, with learned State counsel submitting that her custodial interrogation is not required.

That being so, the interim order passed on 06.10.2021 admitting the said petitioner to interim bail upon her joining investigation, is made absolute on the same terms and conditions.

As regards petitioner no.2, the SSP has stated that it seems from the

video recording provided of the incident, that the petitioner is holding a .315 bore rifle in his hand, with the licence that the said petitioner was holding qua that weapon, already having expired on 21.05.2020 (with the date of the alleged occurrence being 18.08.2021).

That being so, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, the petition qua petitioner no.2 is dismissed.
