The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Through the instant petition under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.169 dated 11.09.2020 for offence under Sections 452, 324, 323, 326 and 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Kalanaur, District Gurdaspur.

Copy of the amended petition has been sent through whats app mode and the print out of the same is taken on record.

Vide order dated 11.11.2020 passed by this Court, the petitioner was released on interim bail and was directed to join investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Satpal states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the said facts, without commenting on the merits of the

case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 11.11.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure
