The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 423 dated 24.11.2018, under Sections 302, 307, 34, 396, 120-B of Indian Penal Code and Section 25 of Arms Act registered at Police Station Ambala City, District Ambala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the FIR. It is contended that the petitioner herein is in custody since 30.01.2019. It is further argued that the material witnesses have already been examined and the injured witness has not supported the case of the prosecution as he failed to identify the accused persons. There is no likelihood of the petitioner herein influencing the

prosecution witnesses in any manner.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State opposes grant of regular bail to the petitioner by contending that no ground for grant of bail is made out keeping the seriousness of allegations levelled against him.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties. The material witnesses have already been examined and the injured has not supported the prosecution version. The trial is likely to take some time to conclude owing to present COVID-19 pandemic situation. No useful purpose would be served in keeping the petitioner behind bars any longer. The instant petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail on his execution of adequate personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate. However, any observation made herein shall not be construed to be an expression on merits of the case.
