The instant petition has been filed under Section 439(2) CrPC for cancellation of regular bail to the private respondent granted by this Court vide order dated 11.08.2020.

On being put to notice by this Court vide order dated 12.11.2020, the State has apprised the Court that the allegations levelled by the petitioner with respect to the alleged threats being extended have been found to be without any substance.

Learned State counsel submits that submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner was being pressurized to withdraw the case against the accused-respondent was belied from the fact that final report under Section 173 CrPC was submitted way back on 03.06.2020 and the alleged threats of withdrawing the case were made only subsequently and that too as recently as in October 2020.

After arguing for some time, when this Court was not inclined to accept the prayer of the petitioner, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to avail alternate remedy, as may be available to him, under the provisions of law.

Dismissed as withdrawn, with liberty as prayed for.
