The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.13 dated 08.01.2020, under Sections 186, 307, 332, 353, 427 and 34 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Bilaspur, District Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR wherein it is alleged that a pick-up vehicle without any registration number was parked and when the police party went near it, 3-4 youngsters, who were sitting in the vehicle, had fled away. The police officials chased the vehicle and when the vehicle was stopped, they had pelted stones at the vehicle. It is also mentioned that one boy had fired a shot but the story appears suspicious as there is no mention of any empty cartridge, which has been recovered, in the status report filed by the ACP, Pataudi. He further contends that it is a case of no injury. The petitioner is in custody for over 08

months.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Ashok states that although the challan has been filed but charges are yet to be framed. He also contends that the petitioner is a habitual criminal and is involved in many other criminal cases.

In view of the above, especially when it is a case of no injury, the petitioner is in custody for over 08 months, Covid 19 pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.

However, the petitioner shall appear before the Police Station, Bilaspur, District Gurugram on every alternate Monday till the conclusion of the trial.
