By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of anticipatory bail, upon FIR no.118, dated 31.5.2020, having been registered at Police Station Dirba, District Sangrur, alleging therein the commission of an offence punishable under Section 420 of the IPC.

The petitioner having been admitted to anticipatory bail vide an order passed by this court on 12.11.2020, thereafter initially counsel for the petitioner had sought an adjournment on 14.1.2021, after which he did not appear on 08.3.2021, with the complainant ordered to be impleaded by this court as respondent no.2 and the hearing in the matter adjourned to 8.4.2021.

Again on that date, counsel for the petitioner did not appear, with the report of the Registry being that despite notice of motion having

been ordered to be issued for service upon respondent no.2, even the process fee had not been filed.

Today, counsel for the petitioner submits that he has no instructions.

Consequently, this petition is dismissed and the interim order dated 12.11.2020 is vacated.
