The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking issuance of a direction for getting his son Tarsem Singh, aged about 35 years, released, who was alleged to have been illegally detained by respondents No.3 to 5 since 02.10.2021.

Reply by way of an affidavit of Shri Pushpinder Singh, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Special Task Force, Patiala Range, Patiala has been filed, which is taken on record. In the reply, it has been deposed that Tarsem Singh had been arrested on 04.10.2021 in connection with FIR No.175 dated 04.10.2021 registered at Police Station STF, Phase-4, SAS Nagar, Mohali under Section 21 of the NDPS Act.

From a perusal of the said reply, it is evident that Tarsem Singh has been in custody since 04.10.2021 in connection with FIR No.175 dated 04.10.2021 and as such, cannot be said to be in illegal custody.

In view of the aforestated position, no further directions are required to be issued in the instant petition. The petition, as such, stands disposed of.

However, the petitioner would be at liberty to have recourse to any other alternative efficacious remedies, in case he still has any grievance, which is unaddressed.
