The petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* for issuance of directions to the respondents to release the gratuity, GPF, GIS and pension of the petitioner along with interest @ 18% per annum from the date of retirement i.e. 30.09.2020 (Annexure P-1) as the same has not been released without any sufficient cause.

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with the directions to the official respondents to consider the

representations dated 12.04.2021 (Annexure P-3) and representation dated 27.07.2021 (Annexure P-4) moved by the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the release of payment, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
