Due to COVID-19 situation, the Court is convened through video conference.

This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is filed seeking quashing of order dated 2.12.2015 passed by Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Nakodar, declaring the petitioner as Proclaimed offender.

On 8.10.2021, following order was passed:

"This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C is filed seeking quashing of order dated 2.12.2015, whereby the petitioner has been declared proclaimed offender in case of FIR No. 35 dated 22.2.2015, under Section 392, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Shahkot District Jalandhar.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sandeep Kumar, DAG Punjab, appearing on advance notice accepts the same.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was out of country when the impugned order declaring him proclaimed offender was passed. The petitioner is coming back to India on 10th October, 2021. He will appear before the Court concerned by 14th October, 2021 and move a petition for grant of bail as well as interim bail.

Let the petitioner appear before the Court on or before 14th October, 2021. In the meantime, his arrest is stayed. The court would be at liberty to impose any such condition to ensure the presence of the petitioner during the course of trial.

Adjourned to 16.11.2021."

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has surrendered before the Court concerned and was granted bail.

Ms. Monika Jalota, DAG Punjab, appears for State of Punjab.

In view of statement made by learned counsel for petitioner, no further directions are called for.
