Though matters were being taken up through physical hearing mode today, this matter has been taken up through video conferencing on specific request of learned counsel and in terms of circular dated 14.09.2021.

Prayer in this writ petition is for directing respondents to immediately open up the culvert near Rectangle No. 81, 82 and 97 situated at State Highway No. 9 while removing any obstruction or encroachment, which leads to water logging of rain water.

Learned counsel for the State, to whom advance copy of the writ petition has been supplied, on instructions from Sh. Daler Singh, Executive Engineer, PWD B&R, Karnal, submits that problem at the spot has been resolved and learned counsel has received a written note from the concerned department that on receipt of the application from the petitioner on 16.08.2021 by respondent No. 1, necessary directions were issued to the concerned officials for effective compliance. Culvert have thereafter been opened and are functional.

In this view of the matter, no order need to be passed in this writ petition, which is rendered infructuous.

Disposed of accordingly.

Needless to say, it is expected that as and when any such difficulty is faced by the petitioner or any other similarly situated person, same be brought to the notice of the respondents and immediate measures, as have been taken in the present case, would be taken in future also.
