Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.336 dated 27.08.2021 registered under Section 174-A IPC at Police Station Model Town, Panipat, District Panipat.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that in a criminal complaint filed under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881, by the respondent/complainant M/s. Falak Janvi, the trial Court vide order dated 18.12.2019 has declared the petitioner as a proclaimed person and further directed to register an FIR under Section 174-A IPC. It is also submitted that subsequent thereafter, on 26.02.2020, the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court in those proceedings and he was granted bail. Lastly, it is submitted that the petitioner is ready to surrender before the Investigating Officer and co-operate throughout.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Deepak Grewal, DAG, Haryana who is present in the Court accepts notice on behalf of the respondent – State and could not disputed the factual position.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating Officer within a period of 10 days to join investigation and he shall be released on interim bail on furnishing bail/surety bonds subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
