After arguing for a while, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition, while submitting that as regards the prayer as made by the petitioner in her application (Annexure P-1) for taking legal action against the private respondents, she would be availing the appropriate and efficacious remedy, as may be permissible to her under law, for this purpose and so far as her prayer for the protection of her life and liberty is concerned, she would be moving a fresh representation to respondent No.1-Police Commissioner, Gurugram or Commissioner of Police, Faridabad, exclusively praying therein for the protection of her life and liberty only and he further prays that the said

authorities be directed to look into and take appropriate action on the fresh representation of the petitioner within some specific time frame.

Mr. S.S. Pannu, learned Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, who has joined the proceedings on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2 in this case in pursuance of the copies of the present petition having been sent to the respondent-State in advance, submits that he has no objection to the above-discussed submission as well as the prayer as made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Resultantly, the petition in hand stands dismissed for having been withdrawn, with a direction to respondent No.1 as well as Commissioner of Police, Faridabad that in case the petitioner moves any fresh representation to either of them restricting her prayer therein for the protection of her life and liberty only, then the addressee Authority shall look into the same and if the petitioner would be found to be genuinely deserving the above-said protection, then the said Authority shall take appropriate action, strictly in accordance with law, in the given set of facts and circumstances of the matter, preferably within a period of ten days.
