By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of 'regular bail' under the provisions of Section 439 Cr.P.C., upon FIR no.32, dated 29.12.2020, having been registered at Police Station GRP Sangrur, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under the provisions of Sections 307, 324, 323, 34 of the IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner not having been named in the FIR (but seemingly as one of the 2/3 unknown persons who had allegedly attacked the son of the complainant), and with no specific injury attributed to him, he may be admitted to bail, with him having been in custody for about 7 ½ months, with the trial still to commence.

Upon query to learned State counsel, though otherwise he opposes the petitioner being admitted to bail, however, he could not deny the aforesaid facts and further submits that a *danda* was recovered from the petitioner.

That being so, looking at the stage of the trial and the period of custody, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, upon his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial court.
