The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.121 dated 17.09.2020 under Sections 354-B, 324, 323, 148 and 149 IPC 1860 registered at Police Station Sadar Kotakpura District Faridkot.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that it is essentially a matrimonial dispute between the complainant and her husband, which led to the registration of the FIR in question against the family members of the husband. He further submits that pursuant to order dated 23.11.2020, passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation. This fact is not disputed by the counsel for the State as well.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sukhwinder Singh states that the petitioners are no longer required for further interrogation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 23.11.2020, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
