AMOL RATTAN SINGH, J. (Oral)Case heard *via* video conference.

This case has been taken up out of turn on the request of learned counsel for the petitioner who submits that the matter has actually been settled between the petitioner and the complainant.

In respect of the aforesaid contention he refers to Annexure P-2, which is seen to be an affidavit executed by Jagat Singh, who is also shown to be the complainant in the FIR (Annexure P-1), with the compensation of Rs.1,50,000/- stated to have been paid to him by the petitioner.

Upon query to learned State counsel he submits that, as per his instructions, there is no other criminal case registered against the petitioner.

That being so, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be admitted to bail, upon him furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial court/CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned.

It is to be noticed that though in the head note of the petition it has been stated that it is a petition filed under the provisions of Section 439 of the Cr.P.C., however, thereafter the phrase 'anticipatory bail' has been used, though in the final prayer clause also he is sought to be released on 'regular bail'.
