1. Learned counsel contends that prayer in the petition is for grant of benefits of ante-dated promotion to the petitioner to the post of SSO at par with similarly situated persons w.e.f. 30.04.2005 i.e. the date on which the post became vacant due to retirement of Smt. Sarojini Devi, SSO / Chemistry FSL, Haryana, Madhuban.

2. Learned counsel contends that the petitioner has submitted legal notice Annexure P/4 dated 10.03.2021 in respect of his grievance which is the subject matter of the writ petition, but no decision has been taken on the same till date and that in the circumstances, the petitioner would be satisfied if the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.1 to consider and decide the claim made in the legal notice Annexure P/4 dated 10.03.2021 in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion to respondent No.1 only.

4. Mr. Tapan Kumar, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1 and after perusal of the writ petition states that he has no objection to the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

5. Accordingly, in view of the statement of learned counsel for the parties but without commenting upon the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.1 to consider and decide claim made in the legal notice, Annexure P/4 dated 10.03.2021 in accordance with law after taking into account all circumstances including delay, if any, by passing a speaking order within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.
6. Petition disposed of with the aforementioned directions.
