The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Through the instant petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0179 dated 29.10.2020 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station City Moga, District Moga.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sirtaj Singh submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation. He has instructions to submit that the petitioner is not involved in any other criminal case. Written statement has been filed

on behalf of respondent No.2, which is taken on record.

In view of the above facts, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 12.11.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
