The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioner has come up in this civil writ petition under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to revise the pension of late Sh. Pala Singh, Ward Attendant, husband of the petitioner as per provisions of the recommendations of the 4th Punjab Pay Commission and by counting the ad-hoc service rendered and also award the arrears of revised Death-cum-Retirement Gratuity alongwith interest @ 12% per annum, for which, legal notice dated 23.10.2020 (Annexure P-8) has also been served upon the

respondent authorities.

Record perused.

In view of the averments made in the petition, the directions are issued to the respondent-authorities to duly consider the legal notice dated 23.10.2020 (Annexure P-8) as representation of the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of passing of this order.

If the petitioner is held entitled for so claimed relief and there is no impediment for granting the same, the relief be released to her without any delay as per law.
