Prayer in the present writ petition, filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of directions to the respondents to upload the workload of Environmental Studies (EVS) Subject for the academic session 2020-2021 on the web-portal of the Higher Education Department, Haryana (respondent No.2) as there is anomaly in displaying the workload of the said subject which is shown as zero on the MIS portal.

Counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners have been working as Extension Lecturers in the said subject in various colleges of the respondent-Department and the guidelines dated 04.03.2020 (Annexure P-3) have been issued that eligible Extension Lecturers are entitled to continue. It is pointed out that the petitioners are eligible as per the said guidelines but are now aggrieved on account of the workload not being depicted.

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Counsel submits that representation dated 11.06.2021 (Annexure P-6) has been served upon respondent No.2, which has been followed up by reminder dated 03.07.2021 (Annexure P-7) but the same has not been acted upon and he would be satisfied if the same is decided within a fixed time-frame as the academic session has already started.

Notice of motion.

Mr.Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Keeping in view the limited controversy as such and since the decision making is still incomplete, no useful purpose will be served to call upon the respondents for filing reply, as it would cause further delay in deciding the proceedings.

Accordingly, without commenting on the merits of the case or the entitlement of the petitioners, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2 to take a decision on the representation dated 11.06.2021 (Annexure P-6) within a period of 10 days from the receipt of the certified copy of this order.
