The petitioner has filed this petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus to direct the respondents to fix the pension of the petitioner and release pensionary benefits to her immediately along with interest up to date as the petitioner stands retired on 29.02.2020, along with certain other prayers.

At the outset, the counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage the petitioner would be satisfied if respondents are directed to decide the legal notice dated 10.10.2020 (Annexure P-2) served by the petitioner, within some time bound frame.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Rajesh Gaur, Additional Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State and submits that the State is not averse to expeditious disposal of grievance of the petitioner.

In view of the above, respondents are directed to take a conscious decision in the legal notice dated 10.10.2020 (Annexure P-2), within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

It is further ordered that in case the petitioner is found entitled to the financial benefits on such conscious decision to be taken by the respondents-State, then the same shall be actually released to the petitioner within a further period of three months from the date of such decision.

The petition stands disposed of with above said direction.
