Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.69 dated 02.03.2019, under Sections 406, 498-A IPC, registered at Police Station Women, Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

By virtue of the order dated 12.07.2021, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation. It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned counsel for the complainant vehemently opposed the prayer

for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. He submits that the mediation has

failed.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Joginder Singh has endorsed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the same, the interim order dated 12.07.2021, is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
