1. Copy of the reply filed on behalf of respondent No.1/State by way of affidavit of Mr. Hans Raj, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Detective, Sonipat is taken on record.
2. The petitioners have approached this Court seeking quashing of FIR No.166 dated 05.06.2018 registered against them at Police Station Civil Line Sonipat, Sonipat, under Sections 498-A/323/406/506/34 IPC and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.
3. Vide order dated 23.11.2020, the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.

4. Report of learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Sonapat, has been received, wherein it has been reported that the statements of accused/petitioners Tapan, Anita Sharma and Mudit Bhardwaj and also of complainant Deepti have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves.
5. The complainant Deepti in her statement has stated that she has no objection in case the FIR in question is quashed.
6. The learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Sonapat has specifically opined that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily without there being any pressure, coercion and undue influence.
7. In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.166 dated 05.06.2018 registered at Police Station Civil Line Sonipat, Sonipat, under Sections 498-A/323/406/506/34 IPC and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed qua petitioners.
