This is the third petition filed by the petitioner under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.44, dated 13.07.2019, Annexure P-1, registered for offence under Sections 376(D), 506 IPC, 1860, and Section 3 of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, at Women Police Station Sonapat, District Sonapat. The first two petitions were withdrawn after arguments on 04.09.2020 and 28.06.2021.

Having argued the matter for sometime and realizing that the Court is not inclined to agree with his submissions, counsel for the petitioner submits that he does not press the petition. He, however, requests that a direction be issued to the trial court to expedite the trial.

Request of the counsel has been considered.
