The grievance of the petitioners is that directions issued by the Commissioner are not being complied with.

A mutation was entered in favour of the petitioners. The same was challenged by way of an appeal and revision without success. In the writ petition filed, an order of status quo regarding possession was made. Thereafter, the District Revenue Officer-respondent No.3, upset the mutation on his own motion. The petitioners approached the concerned Commissioner who got an inquiry conducted, which found that the action of the District Revenue Officer-respondent No.3 was not proper. Thus, direction was issued on 29.07.2021 for restoring the mutation.

The High Court is not the Executing Court for orders passed by the Commissioner. Thus, the writ petition is dismissed with liberty to the petitioners to approach the concerned Commissioner.
