The petitioner is aggrieved because passport allegedly applied for by him has not been issued on account of pendency of a criminal case.

When a trial is pending, an accused may obtain passport for a short duration alongwith permission to travel abroad from the trial Court concerned. The writ petition is not a remedy.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition with liberty to approach the concerned trial Court.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the aforementioned liberty.
