By this petition, the petitioners seek a direction to respondents no.2 to 4 to not harass and humiliate them in the context of the complaint submitted by respondent no.5.

On 08.10.2021 the following order had been passed in this case by this court:-

“Case heard via video conferencing.

By this petition, the petitioners seek a direction to respondents no.2 to 4 to not harass and humiliate them at the behest of complaint submitted by respondent no.5.

Learned counsel for the petitioners would place on record any affidavit/compromise deed between the petitioner and the person who actually made the complaint against the petitioner, i.e.Balwan Singh, because on the compromise deed (copy Annexure P-9), even on the vernacular version thereof), the signatures of Balwan Singh are not seen, though that of his son are there, who allegedly has not been sent abroad by the petitioner despite promises to that effect.

Adjourned to 28.10.2021.”

Thereafter, on 03.11.2021, the following order had been passed:-

Today a request for an adjournment has been made on behalf of learned counsel for the petitioner through the Reader of this court.
