Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Status report dated 20.02.2021, by way of affidavit of the Assistant Superintendent of Police, Kalanwali, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.

Through this petition, the petitioner seeks interim regular bail in case bearing FIR No.43 dated 16.03.2020, under Sections 392, 395 and 120-B IPC (added subsequently), registered at Police Station Baragudha, District Sirsa, for a period of eight weeks to look after his ailing father, suffering from Tuberculosis (T.B.).

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that except for the petitioner, there is no other male member in his family to look after his father, who is suffering from T.B. and is not being properly treated.

On the other hand, learned State counsel opposes the prayer

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made in the present petition.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

As per the status report dated 20.02.2021, the father of the petitioner was getting treatment from 24.08.2020 to 07.02.2021 and his anti tubercular treatment has been completed and he has tested sputum negative. Moreover, CRM-M-15266-2020 filed by the petitioner, seeking regular bail, was dismissed on 30.06.2020 by a Coordinate Bench by noticing that the petitioner is not entitled to the grant of bail, inasmuch as, he had committed very heinous crime of robbery/dacoity.

Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
