Challenge in the instant writ petition is to an order dated 11.08.2021 passed by the Haryana Real Estate Regulatory Authority, Panchkula (Annexure P-9) in Complaint No.464 of 2019 (Kanwar Singh Vs. Mudra Finance Limited).
