AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

Due to COVID-19 situation, the Court is convened through video conference.

This is a petition seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 232 dated 27.9.2021, under Sections 147, 149, 323, 325, 452 and 506 IPC, registered at Police Station Pillukhera, District Jind.

On 11.10.2021, the arrest of the petitioners was stayed.

Though the complainant has not been impleaded as party, Mr. Sandeep Malik, Advocate puts in appearance on behalf of the complainant and submits that the matter has been compromised between the parties.

In view of the above, the petitioners are granted anticipatory bail subject to their joining investigation within a week. In the event of

arrest, they shall be released on bail subject to their furnishing adequate bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer. They are directed to join the investigation as and when called for. They shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition is allowed.

In case of failure of petitioners to join the investigation, the State would be at liberty to file an application for re-calling of this order.
