This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ of mandamus or any other writ or order or directing respondent No.4 to enter the name of petitioner in the register of Haryana State Pharmacy Council and to issue the licence to the petitioner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Gopal Sharma, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondent Nos.3 and 4, who are the contesting respondents; and submits that although the petitioner had deposited the fee meant for verification of the degree of the petitioner, however, the petitioner had not submitted the affidavit giving the details of the institution at which he studied to acquire

that degree. Hence, the same could not be verified in time. Now, the demand draft of the requisite fee, which was earlier submitted by the petitioner stands expired. It is further submitted that if the petitioner submits the requisite fee meant for verification of the degree of the petitioner and also the affidavit giving the details of the institution at which he studied to acquire the degree, then the same shall be verified by the respondents and necessary registration certificate shall be issued to the petitioner after registration, if the degree of the petitioner is found to be in order.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to submit the requisite fee through the demand draft, as well as, the affidavit demanded by respondent Nos.3 and 4 giving the details of the institution at which he studied to acquire the pharmacy degree; within a period of four weeks from today. In case, the petitioner furnishes the requisite fee and the details as mentioned above, then respondent Nos.3 and 4 shall verify the Pharmacy degree of the petitioner. In case, the degree of the petitioner is found to be genuine, then the name of the petitioner shall be registered on the role of the council and necessary certificate shall be issued to the petitioner. This entire exercise is directed to be completed within a period of six months from the date of receipt of the requisite fee and the affidavit; to be submitted by the petitioner, if any.
