HARNARESH SINGH GILL, J. (ORAL)

Through this second petition, the petitioner seeks interim regular bail in case bearing FIR No.05 dated 22.01.2020, registered at Police Station GRP Sangrur, District Government Railway Police, under Section 302 IPC, enabling him to look after his ailing wife.

Status report dated 15.11.2021, by way of affidavit of the DSP, Sub Division, GRP, Patiala, has been filed in the Court today. The same is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the wife of the petitioner has been suffering from psychiatric problem and is getting treatment from Bansal Hospital, Dhanaula, District Barnala; that the petitioner is having two minor children; that his father has since expired and that there is no other male member in the family to look after his ailing wife. It is further contended that owing to the medical condition of the petitioner's wife, the children are under the instancy of a disturbed family

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atmosphere. In such circumstances, the learned counsel prays that the petitioner be released on interim regular bail for a period of 20 days.

On the other hand, learned State counsel submits that the wife of the petitioner is suffering from psychosis illness, but was discharged from the hospital on 07.10.2021, as would decipher from discharge slip (Annexure R-1).

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

Keeping in view the fact that the wife of the petitioner is suffering from psychosis illness and the minor children are residing with her, the petitioner is granted interim regular bail for a period of two weeks i.e. from 22.11.2021 and 05.12.2021, subject to him furnishing of surety/bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate. The petitioner shall surrender before the trial Court/Duty Magistrate on 06.12.2021 at 10.00 a.m.
