1. Prayer in the petition under Articles 226 of the Constitution of India is for the issuance of a writ especially in the nature of Mandamus directing respondent Nos.3 and 4 to make payment of the due amount of Rs.13,81,382/- on account of job work of custom milling of paddy done as per custom milling policy pertaining to crop year 2018-19 besides amount of Rs.48000/- on account of security to the petitioner along with interest @ 18% per annum w.e.f. the date it became due till its actual payment. Prayer is also for the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to consider the representations (Annexures P-3 to P-5) of the petitioner as also claim made in legal notice dated 23.06.2021 (Annexure P-6) in a time bound manner.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner would be satisfied, if the instant petition is disposed of by directing the respondents to consider the representations, Annexures P-3 to P-5 as also claim made in legal notice dated 23.06.2021 Annexure P-6 in a

3. Mr. Ayush Sarna, AAG, Punjab on perusal of the writ petition states that he has no objection to the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

4. In view of the nature of the order proposed to be passed, no reply is necessary. Accordingly, in the light of position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the parties, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of by directing the respondents to consider and decide representations Annexures P-3 to P-5 as well as claim made in legal notice Anneuxre P-6 dated 23.06.2021, in accordance with law after taking into account all aspects of the matter, within six weeks and in case some amount is found due and payable to the petitioner, then payment in respect thereto be made to the petitioner within a period of four weeks thereafter.
