The petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* for issuance of directions to the respondents to count the daily wage service rendered by the petitioner as qualifying service and accordingly fixed his retiral benefits and with a further direction that all arrears may be ordered to be paid to the petitioner along with interest @ 12%.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the release of payment, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.
