The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of order dated 11.06.2009 (Annexure P-6) passed by learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Baba Bakala, District Amritsar in FIR No.110 dated 20.08.2008 under Section 420 IPC registered at Police Station Mehta, District Amritsar Rural, whereby the petitioner was declared as proclaimed offender.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to order dated 24.11.2020 passed by this Court, the petitioner has appeared before the trial Court and has been admitted on interim bail. He further submits that

apart from the fact that the matter has been compromised between the parties, the petitioner undertakes to face the trial in accordance with law.

In view of the above, the impugned order dated 11.06.2009 (Annexure P-6) passed by learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Baba Bakala is set aside qua petitioner Raj Kaur and the order dated 24.11.2020 passed by this Court is made absolute.

The present petition is, accordingly, allowed.

However, the petitioner shall continue to appear before the trial Court and to face the trial in accordance with law.
