This is the first petition under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.300 dated 25.09.2021, registered under Sections 147, 149, 323, 325, 379-B, 384 and 506 of IPC (Sections 325, 379-B and 384 of IPC have been added later on), at Police Station Sector 40, Gurugram.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, after arguing for some time, seeks to withdraw the present petition and submits that the petitioner would surrender before the police within a period of one week from today and prays that in case the petitioner surrenders before the police and applies for regular bail, then the trial Court be directed to decide his regular bail application, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of five days from the date of filing of such application.

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In view of the statement made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn and the petitioner is directed to surrender before the police within a period of one week and in case, he surrenders before the police and applies for regular bail, then the trial Court is directed to decide his regular bail application within a period of five days from the date of filing of such application.
