The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

The petitioners seek grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.248 dated 21.09.2020 registered under Sections 341, 323, 34 IPC (Section 452 IPC added later on) at Police Station City Sunam, District Sangrur.

On 17.11.2020, following order was passed by this

Court:-

“The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the occurrence took place on 15.09.2020. FIR No. 248 was registered on 21.09.2020 under Sections 341, 323 and 34 IPC at Police Station City Sunam District Sangrur. The alleged occurrence took place near the shop of brother of the complainant, namely, Dina Nath in which the complainant and his brother were given beatings by the accused party. The initial offences are bailable in nature. Offence under Section 452 IPC was added later on the alleged supplementary statement of the complainant to the effect that the occurrence took place in the shop of brother of the complainant.

Notice of motion for 13.01.2021.

In the meanwhile, petitioners are directed to appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer to join investigation on 19.11.2020 at 11.00 a.m. and in the event of their arrest, they shall be enlarged on ad interim bail, subject to their furnishing requisite bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, petitioners shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Sandeep Singh submitted that the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of above, order dated 17.11.2020 is made

absolute. However, petitioners shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
