Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 40 dated 07.3.2019 under Sections 307/450/323/427/148/149 IPC and Sections 25/27 of the Arms Act, 1959 and later on added Sections 325/427 IPC and Section 30 of the Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Canal Colony, District Bathinda.

Vide order dated 17.11.2020 passed by this Court, the ad interim anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 17.11.2020 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Bhupinder Singh, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for any further investigation.
